Definitions

Accessible - easy to approach, reach, enter, or use

Agriculture - farming and/or raising livestock

Aquifer - any geological formation containing or conducting ground water

Contaminate - to make unsuitable by contact or mixture with something unclean

Continent - one of the main landmasses of the globe

Disease - extreme illness

Glacier - a huge mass of ice

Hygiene - the promotion and preservation of health

Percentage - a rate of proportion per hundred

Pollution - natural environment being contaminated with harmful substances

Potable - fit or suitable for drinking

Resource - a source of supply, support, or aid

Rural - "of the countryside"

Sanitation - the application of measures for the sake of cleanliness

Scarce - rare

Well - a hole drilled or bored into the earth to obtain water
